Safety Topic

- **Dale Campbell – Dehydration**
 - Dehydration occurs when you use or lose more fluid than you take in, and your body doesn't have enough water and other fluids to carry out its normal functions.
 - **Symptoms** - Signs of mild or moderate dehydration include:
 - Thirst
 - Dry or sticky mouth
 - Not peeing very much
 - Dark yellow pee
 - Dry, cool skin
 - Headache
 - Muscle cramps
 - **Signs of severe dehydration include:**
 - Not peeing or having very dark yellow pee
 - Very dry skin
 - Feeling dizzy
 - Rapid heartbeat
 - Rapid breathing
 - Sunken eyes
 - Sleepiness, lack of energy, confusion or irritability
 - Fainting
