JOE SPEARS – COMMON ELECTRICAL HAZARDS

- 5 workers are electrocuted a week in the US
- 15% increase in fatalities by electrocution
- Younger workers are more at risk
- Types of injury
 - Direct
 - Shock
 - Burns
 - In-Direct
 - Falls from heights
- Hazards
 - Unsafe equipment
 - Take it out of service!
 - Unsafe work practices
 - Overloaded circuits
